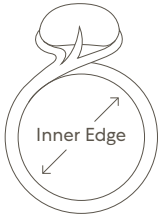


RING SIZE GUIDE

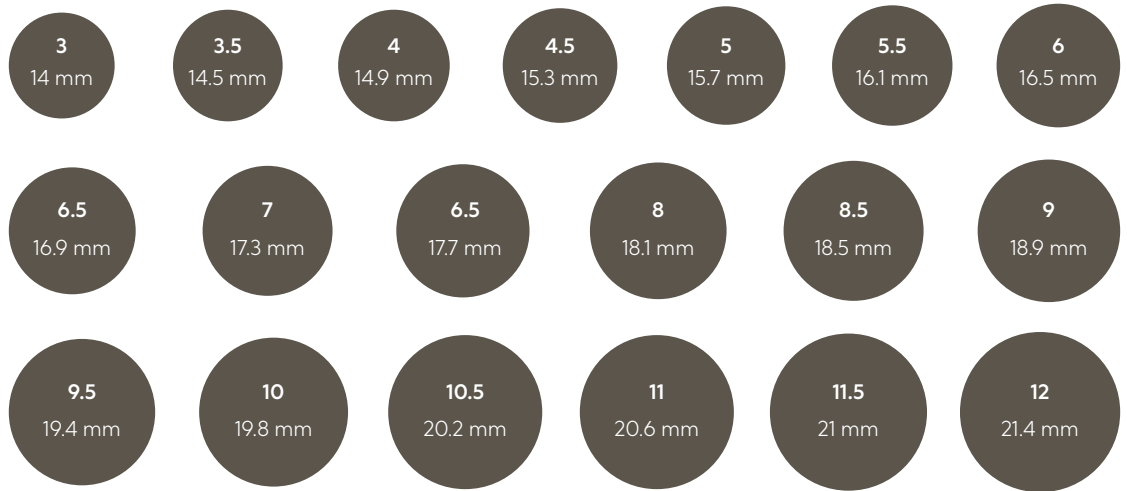


To find your ring size, please print this guide in A4 size and scaled to 100%. You may check the accuracy of your print by measuring the reference line.



Option 01: Measure by matching your current ring

- To find your ring size, use an existing ring that fits you well on the same finger as the Studio Renn ring you are interested in.
- Place one of your existing rings over the circles below, matching the circle to the inside of your ring. You should see only the grey circle—with no white space—inside your ring.
- If your ring falls between two sizes, we recommend choosing the larger size.



Option 02: Measure your finger with paper sizer



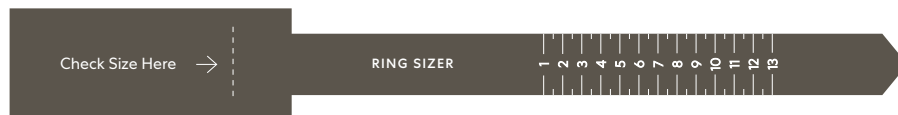
Carefully cut along the outline of the sizer. Make a small slit on the line on the left end of the sizer where you will read the size.



Wrap the sizer around the intended finger with the numbers facing out and pull the tapered end through the slit. The sizer must fit snugly to size accurately.



The number that lines up with the slit represents the ring size for that finger.



Please note that this ring size chart is for reference only. Studio Renn cannot be held liable for any errors that occur as a result of using this chart.

Additional Tips

- The ring size may vary subtly depending on style of the ring. Thicker ring bands (larger than 6mm) will fit tighter. It is advised to always go for half a size up when purchasing a thicker band, for the ring to be comfortable.
- The size of your finger may vary depending on the temperature and time of day. For accurate results, measure the size of your finger at the end of the day. Please avoid taking measurements on hot or cold days.
